so at all DJs
there's no such thing as a fake DJ
and then we have a double news
I don't care
you have to die
are there vocals in this song?
I don't
Bidi Bidi Bom Bom
that's really her vibe
that's really her vibe
Bom Bom Bom
but you already know this
there was a time on my list

a bit with the same reasons as you
I have nostalgia for her as a figure
and
I think I've already heard it
in a few podcasts
I've never seen the film
and then we'll look at it together
we'll look at it together
okay
then we'll start
we're going to work on the chronology
let's start with her
birth
Selena Quintanilla

she was born on 16th of April
1971 in Texas
her mother Marcella is from Cherokee

so Abraham is from

so I think Selena has that
Latino roots
but how did they come up with Suze
it's a nice name
but I think all three are very varied
maybe that's the mother
of Marcella
Suze can also
I think
maybe it's on that side

I don't think you have to coordinate everything
but I saw those three names
and I thought
I'm curious what the story is about
call me Abraham Junior
son Abraham is
Abraham the third
but we're not going to start
but we'll say papa and Abraham for her brother
or papa Abraham
my father Abraham
why didn't you say that yet?
I'm tired
but we're born
how long have we been together?
we've been together for 6 years
Selena and
father Abraham
then suddenly
Selena can sing a song
he has a certain talent
he can
keep her tone
I've seen that from day one
and father Abraham
was also a musician
so he knew where he was
now
in 1980
so when Selena was 9 years old
on the
I'm not going to say father Abraham
Abraham Junior
a Tex-Mex restaurant
papa Gaius
and what does he do
to make people laugh?
he puts Selena to the stage
Selena sang
Abraham the third played the bass
and Suzette played the drum
but unfortunately
a year later he had to close the restaurant
because of the recession

oil crisis in the United States
I'm sorry that you don't keep the name
of the band
I'm going to do that
it's nice to keep the name
Selena y los dinos
oh but also with a little
I practiced that
you know
that I have spanish roots
that's not true
sorry
sorry but you said
the restaurant has to close
the family
has to file for bankruptcy
and they have to
move to Corpus Christi
in Texas
Vibe
and with their source of income
the restaurant decided
to file for Selena y los dinos
Selena y los dinos
the band
begins to record
professionally
and in 1984
they released
their first LP
in a small
in a small
small record company
so it's not yet
signed
have you ever heard about the music genre
that they play?
no but I would like to
just
a little mini step back
I think it's really good
let's say in the beginning of the video
we're going to talk chronologically
no but we are both very golden

but I think it's good
no
let's say
that band
that was the main income
of the family at that time
there was nothing else
but Abraham still believes
in the career of Selena y los dinos
that he
sees an old bus
he thinks he's going to buy it
we're going to tour with it
the whole Texas
and they sing
just to make sure they can buy food
but they do have ampers
just the situation
that's it
and then they're going to record the LP
so I just
wrote down
the music genre
because I don't know
the name
I'm going to call it Tejano
I have it in Google Translate
and it sounds like
90%
that was
because we're not in Texas
that's the border
with Mexico
because that's a border
where there are a lot of mixed
people
where the American
and the Mexican people
are connected
so I got mixed
I'm going to continue
so that influence
of one side Latino music
but on the other side American music

that Tejano music
genre
I still have a little influence
because it's like
German and Czech influence
because you're American
no, it's people who
are migrated to the United States
but it's about genres like the polka
and the waltz
so that's what it's about
so if you listen to Selena
and listen to the accordion
classic German
and Czech influence
I have to
think of the mariachi bands
also, I think
Schlagerfestival but then
Latino
I know it's funny
but then in a Mexican
way
look, I'm sold
I have to convince myself
of the Tejano
and what I also notice
and the music that Selena makes
speaks no Spanish
I think that's absurd
because her father is
of Mexican origin
and even he
speaks no fluent Spanish anymore
I don't know that
but he says to Selena
you go to Tejano music
you're going to do that
because this is super popular music
and I learn it phonetically in Spanish
but it also has to be Mexican-Spanish
because otherwise
you're going to Mexico
so with

absolutely
insane
and what I think is
that was at that time
in the late 80's and 90's
the most popular
genre music of Latino
so now you have
pop music
reggaeton
and Tejano is a term that
unfortunately still exists
but then in the late 80's and 90's
it was just the most popular
genre music
and good, oh I went really well
the last few days
but it's really a vibe
when you give a garden party
and you want
cool festive music
this is it
but the only problem
of course is Selena is a woman
and Tejano music is
very male dominated
the Texan clubs
are not really capable
to take that part of Selena
despite the fact that they took on LP
in order to
play it and nobody really believes
in it and what Selena
is doing
but look
the popular wind
because in 1987
they won
on the Tejano Music Awards
the Female Vocalist
of the Year
and on that prize
the name of the song
and that means a big record

and they close a deal with
Capital Emmy
Emmy is still here today
the Latin
section
and that contract
is signed in 1889
she is
15 years old
15
I had ships on the bus
when I was 15
that's things from your song
Sandra Kim
she was 14
but that wasn't right
that's true
so Sandra Kim takes a year later
that was also a deep period
that's a deep period
now
that year
the debut album
will be released
but on the other hand
there will be something fun to do
because Chris Perez
will be there
and that's the new guitarist
from the band
and Chris
he will develop his feelings
for Selena
now that I say it
and I know that Selena is 15
I don't know how old she is
how old is he?
and he tries to express his feelings
for her
but he finds it so difficult
classic Romeo and Juliet
he finds it so difficult
to build up a relationship
and then in the end

in a pizza hut
they have known each other
he is from 1969
and he was born in 1971
so he is 17 at the moment
that's not so dramatic
about his other relationship
so
pizza hut
conference
pizza hut
but they decide
to keep a relationship
because they are afraid
that papa Abraham
will not do well
so those two
sneak peek in
Big Bertha on the back bank
and then in 1999
Selena will release her second album
it's going really well
she is an international star
in Mexico as in the United States
we had a break
because I was born in 1999
I mean in 1990
so in 1990
she released her second album
I already said international star
in Mexico as in the United States
and there comes the new person
in her life and that's Yolanda Saldívar
Yolanda is in charge
of Selena
it wasn't the first time
she is something older
12 years older than Selena
and she is a big fan
of Tejano Music
in the mid-80s
she has a vibe
from concert to concert
different bands

and when Selena comes
in the business
with her music
Yolanda has something like
that she is
Selena wins different awards
in the place of bands
where Yolanda was initially a big fan
she has something like
snatching all the prizes
a bit of the Kanye with the Taylor
really like who are you
you don't deserve this
but you have to give Yolanda
what she is
in the mid-90s
she has something like
I'm going to take a poll
about Selena's concerts
in San Antonio, Texas
and she sings a bit
with the audience
we have a conversation
and she looks at the concert
and she is sold
Selena comes to the stage
the presence she has
her voice
everything, a total package
the total package is right
and Yolanda takes care of her
the day after the concert
she says
where is the shop
where can I find the tracks
a lanyard
a magnet
I have to have something from Selena
but she doesn't find anything
and then Yolanda thinks
that is a hole in the market
Yolanda seems to be with slams
she says she doesn't have it yet
maybe I have to do it

and there is some discussion about it
Yolanda says
to the manager of the band
Papa Abraham calls
Papa Abraham
says he has called me 15 times
so there is a small
disruption
Papa Abraham
takes the phone
and Yolanda
says
there is a fan club
from Selena
you sell concerts here
but you don't have t-shirts
Selena is not the first star
to sell that merch
I know the story of Selena
but I have learned a lot
but it all comes later
but there has been a lot of things in the pioneer
apparently also in the merch
every t-shirt from Beyonce
sold yesterday
thanks to Selena
Yolanda has a plan
love the nineties
people can sign up
in the fan club
they stop money in the envelope
in RUAL they get an official
welcome in the club
they also get merch
and they are first kept
on the high of new concert data
does that happen via facebook?
no, instagram? no
you get a folder of
next week you are going to sell the ticket
and if you lose a letter in the post
you don't know
Yolanda explains
Papa Abraham

for \$25
you are a year old
of the Selena fan club
yes, indeed
but at that moment
is Susette
the sister of Selena
the contact person
between the family and Selena
and Yolanda
and Yolanda meets Selena
in December of 1991
so half a year later
after she came up with the idea
but in the end
everyone is like
love her
and Selena immediately
I don't know how old Yolanda is
but she is a 12 year old
sorry, that you said
sorry, excuse me
but those two are really besties
if it were
so you are going to do it
the fan club is up
and then Selena and Chris
her lover
oh my
March via the post
smooth with a boy in a back of a bus
and those two are still
crazy in love
we are between two years later
sorry, I am crazy in love
but you are still happy with us
it is really a golden ending
about Evelyn
now Papa Abraham
is still not at the height
of what is going on
I have a question for Papa Abraham
sorry, how blind are you?
how long have you been in a relationship?

because they are on a tour
and after a day together
now
until our sister comes
because she suddenly sees Chris
and Selena
smooth on the back of the bus
and they are going to click
on their father as a old sister
yes, but I think
maybe sister
can have an eye on Chris
that is my whole feeling
just like we don't know if they are on the back of the bus
and by the way, before you think
I already forgot
but we are still in a relationship
now
I will come back to that
because
Abraham is of course furious
that Chris
my Selena is on a date
and he says to Chris
dude, the relationship is over
if you don't mind
then I will put you out of the band
but despite that
I really like
the rebellious children
but mama Marcela
has a good feeling
so it's not that the whole family
is against Chris
that's true, classic papa
the first time you have to give your child to a lover
yes, but then
Abraham sees how Chris and Selena
are on the tour bus
but is that still the big Bertha of the first time?
absolutely
I mean
that girl sells merch
but in the meantime, she is so pissed

by Xebit
yes, in the 90's she forgot
ok, let's go further
now Abraham says
stop the bus
stop the bus now
we step out
and then
don't move that bus
ok, and there is
a fight between Abraham and Selena
and he
says about Chris
he felt like the cancer
in my family
so those are tough words
but you have to
deal with that Chris
because why would you use
such tough words
he is in the band
that's the only group
that stays behind you
you put him in the band
and again
if you go further
then we stop the band
then we look for other bands
but Selena and Chris
we are not going to have a father
so what does he do
he walks away
those two
and they are going to marry him
because Selena has
something like that
if I'm married
then we can't make anything else
what does he do
Abraham
he will know that through the media
because the media is right on the high
of what has happened
Abraham pulls himself back

he goes in a cocoon
he is mucking
you know what
the classic
momager
Chris Jenner's dream
namely you are a father
and also manager
you don't want to see each other anymore
and you want to control yourself
that's not how it went
and now that they were married
Selena and Chris
they are married
so they are going to live in an apartment
in Corpus Christi
and
eventually Chris explains
why he has
such strong feelings
about Chris
and he says I'm afraid
because he is afraid
that he and Chris
will take over Selena
and say one thing
that we are married
that you are just at the heart
your career is over
we are going to close a family
and that's it
and there was
dad Abraham was very afraid
but
finally Abraham has
talked to Chris
he said he has no intention
he is in the band
why would he give that up
his own brother
so
in the end he lost it
good move
we can also talk about

two men
who decided to leave one woman in their 90s
thank you
keep it there
we are going to
1994
and Yolanda is doing well
yes
she already has more than 8000 fans
on the list
that's enough
8000 fans with 22 dollars
that's Kassa Kassa
yes indeed
it's going to be so good
that she decides to tell her job as a nurse
but they still earn less
in the head of the club
than as a nurse
and the thing is
they earn less
and they also
do it for personal reasons
they are
good friends with Selena
but they still remain a big fan
her move is not
this is a job and I can finish it
she loves it
her life is 24x7
Selena has less money
as a loan
but I understand
there are many people
who think
that they earn less
but they don't do what they like
you just have to do what you like
if you take something from this podcast
then this is it
do what you like
see that you can pay
a tip from us
follow for more tips

also in 1994
when superstars
made a few records
there must be a clothing line
I have to say
I saw the name
of her shop
we can't open a webshop
we are in the middle of the 90's
so boutiques are opened
we are both in
the city of Texas
I think it's a shame
that we can't call
our merch
because her merch is called
Selena Etc
that's not a limit
if it can still
if it can, I want to sell cows
it can
also share
it can
it can all
Selena Etc
2 boutiques
they have to find someone
who has to keep the boutiques open
we are there with
a top employee of the fanclub
president of the fanclub
who has a little too little money
you can work even more
and then you get more money
and you also get the head of
those 2 boutiques
they don't have to be in the shop
it's really about the manager
of the shop, stock purchase
you have to ship the items
to all the fans
once a year because they are in the fanclub
do you see that
and Yolanda said

thank you, I'm super happy
I want to do this
so I get
a credit card
with which you can pay
you can make costs
you get more money, you get a
GSM
an extra legal advantage
before the win or she gets mail
I don't know
but it looks good
Yolanda was a super good employee
it's a logical solution
that this job went to her
it also seems very good
thanks to the boutiques
that are there
is Selena
from 1993 to 1994
really
in the top 20
of the richest Hispanic
musicians
in the United States
that went over 5 million dollars
that's not bad
but you have to know
you have to live that family
because nobody else has an income
income
in the end
so that 5 million
what she does next
is it pre-belasting
or post-belasting
I don't know
sorry Dieter
sorry Lennart
for these weird statements
with the good
but sorry you work too hard
and meanwhile she also brought album number 4
Amor Prohibido

and there is still the news
in 1994
oh my god
that's the picture I know
it's
I'm going to post the photo
but she wins
a Grammy Award
that's one of the most important music prizes
not the most important music prize
it's a classic, she knows him
Beyonce often has photos with Adèle
Billie Eilish
they are those small gramophones
so on the 36th edition
of the Grammy Awards
at the age of 23
with her previous album Selena Live
The Grammy for Best
Mexican American Album
that was then a category
I think that's the category
Latin or Urban or Swiss
that's possible
it's a super nice photo
it has a nice hairdo
it has a silver glitter
we're going to share it
that's the picture that I
remember
I didn't remember
when I was 94
I was 2
you know what should have been a lock
that's my core memory
Selena on the Grammys
we're already
in 1994
really good
good
now December 1994
it rolls around
and the boutiques
it's going to be a bit less

it's going to be a lot more
because
the workers are being beaten
by Yolanda
but the fellow workers
they say they don't like us
we did our work well
but
the workers don't just complain
about that
they also say Yolanda's behaviour
is a bit weird
but Selena has something
what are you talking about?
she's my bestie
of course
now
our dad Abraham
he says
I'm going to take those claims seriously
and he says
Yolanda
may be a bad influence
but we know the people
who know dad Abraham
Yolanda is wrong
Selena says
dad leave me alone
I'm a married woman
I can make my own decisions
we talked about dad Abraham
that you don't have to live with women anymore
so dad Abraham in the mall
is similar to that
anyway
straight tunnel physical bad people
but it doesn't just stay
with the workers who complain
because Selena also had a clothing
for Selena
etc
and she also starts to complain
about Yolanda
and he says

look, I suspect Yolanda
that if she made a fashion show
clothes broke
and she really behaves like a dictator
so he complains
what happens?
he's going to beat us up
I don't know if the clothes are a man or a woman
so he's going to
complain that Yolanda was
going to complain about him
so we already have
two sides of criticism
and then comes the disadvantage
there comes
a third wind direction
where complaints come
and that's the fans
and that's dangerous
there are letters from fans
who say I'm a member
of the Selena club
I paid my \$22
but I never received my product
because I'm a member
of the club
and then the tears begin
with an Abraham
to wrinkle
he's in a tunnel vision
and he thinks we're with three
different groups of people
who complain about one person
and I would like to
do a review
I have a fourth category
the pairs
everyone knows
Yolanda is
well-known in the world
everyone knows that she's the president
would he call us?
I think so
so he's interviewed

and
those people
are really sweet
obsessive
to Selena
and there are also workers
who say
that Selena is
and what also appears
at her house
she's head of the fan club
but it's full of merchandise
but for her
so posters
photos, burning cards
really a shrine
so people now get
bad vibes
so you have the border
and you can search for the border
but now we're talking about it
that there are financial problems
so there were red flags
and Abraham thinks
that's what's made, I'm going to deny
but then the shops
that sell
weird credit cards
that come in
so Abraham
who asks for credit cards
and he sees it
we know
Yolanda got the American Express
Visa card
to pay rent
to pay bills
but all of a sudden
cars are rented
on the credit card
more people who haven't
agreed
expensive food
unadulterable on data

where there shouldn't be work
where there are no agreements
and not one but two GSM's
that are used
and the costs that are connected
and he still talks
with his daughter Selena
and says we're going to stop
the cooperation
they can stay friends
this is pure professional
you can keep in touch
but we're going to get from the shop
because it would seem
to go around 60.000
dollars that would have been
clear with the
confirmed checks and more
but Abraham
Yolanda is going to confront
with his findings
it's then March 9, 1995
but Yolanda says
I don't know, the fans want
to get the merch free
and they lie that they have paid
and the meeting
stops suddenly
Yolanda has done her story
when she stands up
very abruptly and walks away
and it's then that Abraham
says to Selena
we're not going to do this anymore
it's too strange
but Selena
doesn't have to listen
but she obviously
has a lot to do with Yolanda
and she doesn't want to end the friendship
and above all
they can dissuade her
but Yolanda is still in the possession
of some important papers

for Selena's company
but she's been doing this
for years
I can imagine
you can imagine someone like her
but you still have to
do the transfer
so what they decided
is that we don't officially
transfer her to the payroll
but she doesn't work for us anymore
but she still stays on the payroll
so it's easier for her to
get the documents
so it's the transfer
now
that was on March 9
so we're on March 31
and Yolanda and Selena
still have contact
despite Abraham's ban
and Yolanda
stays in a motel
also in Corpus Christi
and look, she says
we still have the documents
I'm going to give you
final assignment
we're friends, let's end it in a nice way
and Selena
goes to that motel
and Yolanda drops a bomb
because she's still in Mexico
because she also wanted
to open a boutique
and Yolanda has been there
she comes back
from Mexico
and she says, look, I've been there
for power
Yolanda is Selena's best friend
so Selena is in shock
and she says, okay, we have to do something
Selena takes Yolanda

they go to the hospital
in Corpus Christi
they go inside
and Selena calls Yolanda
and says, look, we can see a doctor
this happened
a doctor is coming
and she tells Yolanda
what to do
and she blocks
Yolanda can tell
what's going on
she doesn't tell herself
what's going on
she tells Yolanda
what's going on
that's a star
that's sitting there
she wants to support her
and all of a sudden
that story gets stuck
and she says
I understand
we want to help
but it's not possible
because these misdeeds are not here
and you're also not a resident
of Corpus Christi
or you have to give your crimes
where they happened
or you're a resident
but we can't help you here
I really hope that
I was right when I thought about the last one
and I thought, is this Belgium?
sounds very Belgian
no, we can't help you here
but in the hospital
we don't do medical care
the story takes half an hour
Selena says
look, I'm going to put you back
so if you do that yourself
you're not going to do anything else

I don't care
she says
look, I think it's good
if we stay away for a while
especially
not to bother
but let's just
do our own thing
but Selena is going to
go inside the hotel
and there
there's also a rush
there are motel guests
who
are actually going to complain in the lobby
that they hear a noise argument
in the room of
Yolanda
and it's actually about the case
it's about the documents that the rush is made
Selena
would have said to Yolanda
that she can no longer trust Yolanda
and that she actually had to give
the papers back to Selena
why do motel guests
hear that?
there's a clergyman who says
around 11.48
he hears a noise
it was like a
tape
suddenly in the lobby
Selena is threatening
bleeding out of her chest
her clothes were under her blood
and she left a blood spore
of about 119 meters
Selena is calling for help
she was obviously shot down
and behind her
Yolanda is coming
who has a gun
she's still pointing at Selena

she's calling for help
but Yolanda was
very calm
just like in that meeting
when she was very calm and then
she just walked away
to her motel room
as if there was nothing on her hand
a minute later
in the lobby Selena falls down
help services are being added
Selena is afraid of death
she's calling for help
she's calling for help
she's going to shoot me down
close the door
the help services arrive
1 minute 55 seconds after the phone
is off
Selena is transferred to the hospital
where clinical death is declared
she's still on the operating table
but
her right ear was damaged
her right ear was damaged
and she lost a lot of blood
for 50 minutes
doctors have tried to save her
but on 31 March 1995
on 31 March 1995
5 to 1 noon
Selena is finally declared dead
like 23
and quickly
it turns out that the last words
were
Yolanda 158
and Yolanda is transferred
to the motel room 158
she's been murdered
she's been murdered
the people in the lobby
have seen the murderers
walk away

together with the ambulance
the help services arrive
to the motel
in search of Yolanda
the murderer of Selena
and they find her back
in her car
with a revolver against her sleep
for 9 hours
Yolanda will stay in the car
with around her
thousands of fans
who are cheering
because the news is spreading
police next to her
during the 9 o'clock
with her going to the police
in the first hours
she says
and at the end of the 9 o'clock
she will be evaluated
I shot Selena
I shot her
the police has stolen her
empty tank
so that they can't drive away
and they are trying
to get the revolver
to her sleep
and at the end of the night
to take her to the police office
in the afternoon
it happens
of course
you would think
breaking news
as we know it now
it will be in your notifications
of HLN, VT, the news board
why you are subscribed
but also in 1985
you had something like
breaking news
it flows through

the press on the radio stations
and
even more than with us
you really have a lot of radio
if you want to listen to
Bibles Rock music
do you want to
listen to Kpop
is there a radio station
and you also have
several Tejano radio stations
very local
who are picking up news
and they have to
continue to play on the radio
it is true
Selena has shot her down
she has not survived
Tejano radio stations
that play nonstop music
at the reception of the radio stations
they call people
is it a joke?
no, it is not a joke
so they have to continue to play
also on news stations
the 9-hour-long Steyndorf of Jolanda
with the police
all the fans who come closer
they are angry
because they are looking at the murders
and there are journalists
looking at the reaction
of the fans
it was the same with the death of John Lennon
Kurt Cobain or J.F. Kennedy
there are a lot of Americans
who had no idea who Selena was
people who did not listen to the music
who did not live on the border
but the people who were her fans
who really lost their battle
it was Princess Diana
so I still have something

for the autopsy
now
it seems that the bullet
that is behind
she was shot with her back
to Jolanda when she was shot
and that bullet went through the right
top of her back
her body was inside
so right next to her shoulder
she went through her chest
she cut through a scar
and went through the top
of her right chest
so in a few minutes
that scar was touched
Selena lost all her blood
and to make it even more tragic
to make it even more tragic
if the bullet was only one millimeter
higher or lower
then her wounds would have been
much less real
and she probably survived
yes, the thing is
I knew beforehand that she was going to die
because I know this story
but if you
in a crime or in a movie
but in a scar it always looks like
that's okay, she's going to survive
you don't think that
it's a crucial point
like for example
when you are shot in the head
that means you know
that's done
but here the fact that
one millimeter difference
that difference could be
in life and death
that's unlikely
now we will go to the right
of Jolanda

of course she is innocent
she keeps saying that it was a accident
do you believe that?
no
for you she was shot to die
yes, I really think that
she shot the question
that if Selena can't have
then nobody
yes, I don't know
I'm always doubting
I think she was shot to do a shooting
and effectively a scar
or something like that
I think she wasn't killed
but she was shot
yes, but there are people
but I also think that nobody was shot
so if she was shot
then she was shot to die
but I think when you see
it was really an obsession
it was really a
stalker
for both sides of stalker
absolutely
how she got used to it
in that family
she got used to it
she probably got used to it
by Selena's family
there is that discussion
and then Selena says
I don't want to be friends with you anymore
that's the ultimate story for Jolanda
and I think
the idea of
if I can't have her
then nobody
it can be
I think
I think
action before and after
was

she was just
impulsively shot and then
she could die
there could be a lot in one second
of course
but it was also that
she hadn't bought weapons for a long time
that is a remarkable
detail
why would she suddenly
need it
sorry
I didn't write it down
but they do
think that Jolanda
tried it earlier
to kill her
but that's hard
that's true
but they think that Jolanda
Selena already wanted to
lock Selena up
to kill her with a smooch
but that's what I noticed
we are in a right hook
it's a right hook
we are never going to know
but we want to speculate
Jolanda is innocent
that it's about an accident
and on 23 October 1995
the jury goes to court
and after two hours
they come out again and we know
what that means, guilty
they get the maximum life sentence
and they can
be released after 30 years
and that would be in 2025
to realize that the crimes
that happened in the 90s
and you think, at least 30 years
that's about
so many years already

and what I find remarkable
Jolanda is in prison
and she is in isolation
for 23 hours a day
in a cell that is
2.5 meters long
because she gets so many
from other prisoners
and what that is
is that
when she was arrested
she said
she might be released
but a lot of people
from Mexico said
hey guys, we want to pay for that
because if she comes out
we will shoot her down
because it's not just the fans
that say, I make her broken
even one of the biggest
Mexican mafia families
they put a price on their heads
and they say
we will earn all that money
we will do our best
we will do our best
we will put a price on Jolanda
as soon as she comes out
the one who will bring it to life
will be released
we are a big mafia family
we can protect everyone
we will have immunity
we will not be in the hands of the police
and with a lot of money
we are probably one of the uninhabited
big mafia base
Tatuages
that day goes to Selena Luistert
and on all those concerts
she bought the VIP ticket
and the daughter with it
and she says

don't do that with me
I don't like that
the idea is
the day after the murder
a wave was organized in Corpus Christi
where 3000 fans came
that day
the day after that
fans were able to bring their goods
to Selena
fans have 1,5 km to bring their goods
and there are 30 to 40,000 people
on board
I thought it was funny
that the parents were initially
a little understanding of the plan
with a closed choice
something like
we are not going to do it too big
and then quickly by the waves
started to realize
they really had to keep the budget
in a convention center
a lot of known artists
to go to the artists are encouraged
a lot of fans who are
for the last goods
the artists
there were a lot of artists on the budget
so the fans were allowed to bring a last goods
but there is a fan who also
does not appear on the budget
but 5000 roses has let him go
oh
oh, poor me
I just want to say that if we go on tour next year
I can release with 5000 roses
I can release with 5000 roses
then you can live at home
then you can live at home
now
the understanding
it was also healthy on local radio stations
but there the family

no attitude to give
so that's a very bad idea
now you already said
had a mega impact
on the society
there you already said
with John Lennon, Elvis Presley
and further
of the extreme
economic deaths
now who at that moment
governor is from Texas
is George W. Bush
once president
of the United States
and two weeks after the death of Selena
in April the 16th
that will be Selena Day
in Texas and many people are happy with it
but
the white Americans
to say is not happy with it
because that is on Easter that year
and they are so sorry
but Easter can really not be Selena Day
but they do not have it to a certain extent
and Selena Day is now officially a thing
so in my head
apart from the mafia base
George W. Bush is also a very big fan
that's for me now
the Selena public
those people
what I was against
but I found very interesting was
People magazine
that's something we know today
that's
maybe earlier than the humor
that's a bit more serious
a mix I think
maybe the TV family
it's not a painful role
it's a celebrity

yes
and we know it now
when a Kim Kardashian
is crowned as a child
People magazine brings a special edition
that was in the 90's
apparently not yet
after Selena's death
they decided to make a kind of
package edition where they
release interviews
people leave the word
and publish the most beautiful photos
and the week after death
People magazine
and the first day
there were a million copies sold
the first two prints
something they don't normally do
printings are sold out in two weeks
and it's the first time
the head editor of People magazine
tells us that it's a kind of
collector's item
and that later brought to mind
that with important events
we can release a collector's item
the first version of that
was Selena's death
very good
we talked about the film
with Jennifer Lopez
she came out in 1997
Jennifer Lopez got a lot of
criticism on that
because she said Puerto Rican roots
and not Mexican roots
but Jennifer Lopez
was not yet known
and did it so well
that Jennifer Lopez
became mega known
after the film was released
I can't believe that she wasn't known

that's my fault
I can visualize the film
and she sings
she acts
and that's great
but when I saw the film
Jennifer Lopez
she said
I wanted to act
I'm an auditioner
but after the film I realized
that she was an actress
let's get loud
if she was re-cast
sorry guys
it ended up between two actresses
and Jennifer Lopez
became thanks to her Puerto Rican roots
so
thanks to Serena
thanks girl
thanks to Jennifer Lopez
the gift that keeps on giving
in 2002
decided a judge
to throw the weapon
with which Serena
was killed because of her
and to throw the pieces
in the body of Christy Bay
but the drama
I have to meet that judge
I see that
the judge has permanency
and he has something like
let's stir the pot
what can I do to
make it spicy in my career
I'm going to make it spicy
they are also there
they are also spicy
and also skilled
because she said
this is an important part

of the story
how would people react
if it was a story where John Lennon
