They give a heart massage to a young woman, Latifah Hachmi.

She's in the living room on the ground.

The agents arrive.

Her whole body is under the blue spots.

She had a heart attack.

And when the agents arrive, they hear a lot of loud music.

It's the way they can describe it best.

It's someone who is quoting some kind of parlando verse.

It seems that there are no refugees in this apartment.

But there are a number of strange items that can be found back.

They can be spread over all rooms.

There are water bottles of 5 litres.

Some of them are full, others are empty.

In the bathroom, there are hairs everywhere.

So in the bathroom, on the tiles, on the ground.

The agents speak to the man.

The 26-year-old Latifah's man.

His name is Murat.

There was a problem.

Why did you have to call the whole service?

And he says, look, I left here this morning.

She had a headache.

Latifah had a headache.

She went to the bathroom to help with the heavy headache.

And I just met her this morning.

And that's why I called the whole service.

She was unconscious at the moment I arrived here.

Latifah is called to the hospital.

She called.

She brought her.

And she's taking care of the patient the same evening.

The doctors there talk about a suspect.

And the parcel of Brussels is also going in there

and decides to investigate the case.

Yes.

And the doctors immediately go to the hospital.

And they immediately take care of the patient.

The first thing they see is that Latifah has symptoms about her whole body.

And there is an article by Humo, among other things, a very clear article about the case.

It is written that Latifah's body was saved

from bruises or blue spots, even her face.

Now, what seems to be the cause?

There are hundreds of shots with a bot foot.

The doctor thinks of a baseball in the first place.

But Latifah died because of a lot of bleeding.

And her lungs had water.

And that would have been the result of a terrible dip in water until she almost got stuck.

Now, the question is, of course, where did Latifah die?

But they can't say that for sure.

So, the doctor says that in the days before her death,

Latifah was beaten more than 100 times with brute force

and in a huge, violent way.

She had a lot of heart-rhythm disorders

and in a coma-like state, only she would have died of it.

Now, she almost got drunk.

The doctor said, near drowning,

in the English language,

because Latifah started breathing in water,

which would only have contributed to the coma

and her heart-rhythm disorders.

So, that's not good at all.

So, Murat is brought up again.

And she is questioned for hours.

And then, Murat gives the guestion

that he and Latifah have made a group

on a group of Islamic exorcists.

And Murat says during those questions,

my wife was possessed.

The blue spots on her body are the work of the devil.

All right.

Flashback, a small biography of Latifah Hachmi,

the family she grew up in, and so forth.

She's the youngest of four children in the family Hachmi.

It's a family of Moroccan immigrants.

The only girl had three older brothers.

Her father was named after the princess,

and she was treated by her mother,

but also by the three brothers.

She was the apple of the family.

The father was Capor,

and he had the mother of Latifah in Brussels.

She was a hubby of love,

no one arranged her hubby.

She was not very broad,

but she had everything she needed.

Latifah's parents were religious,

but not strict.

Latifah's brother convinced that he,

as a young adult,

went in search of the meaning of Islam for him,

because his parents were not really working with him.

Latifah's brother, his name is Fuat,

brings up good memories.

Susanne tells her,

that she never knew that she was a cat.

She was the only one she really wanted.

She was her own family.

She referred to the TV series

The Little House on the Prairie.

That was the kind of family she had in front of her.

Fun fact, I'm called Neralora Ingels,

one of the characters from The Little House on the Prairie.

So my mom will recognize her here.

Latifah grew up to build a warm, real family.

At the age of 12, she went to the middle school,

like everyone else,

and she came to a community school in Wollewee.

That's a community in Brussels.

Fuat clarifies,

that she and the community

meant that there were autochtones in the classroom in Belgium.

Latifah followed a scientific direction there,

and everything went very well.

Until Latifah came to her puberty.

Yes, because Latifah makes it clear

that she wants to wear a headscarf.

Fuat immediately said,

like other people,

she wanted to be a punk or a god,

so she wanted to wear that headscarf.

The profiler, that's what you do when you see it.

But the only problem was,

at that school you didn't have to wear a headscarf.

Fuat tells her,

and her father,

please let Latifah wear that headscarf.

But that was refused. And Latifah didn't want to wear it either. They said, I want to wear that headscarf. Her father said. do it at school, do it at night, try to find some compromises, but Latifah continued to like it. What made her change from school? And in the article, another article that we read, I believe it's from the standard, Latifah leaves to a school in Schaarbeek and it's described as a ghetto school. No, the words of Fuat. And he says, if I remove the education system and the Belgian education system, then that's it. I'm sure Latifah had an open mind if she could stay in Wollewa. Because he thinks that headscarf was a kind of moving phase. If they put that down again, we can't say anything about that. And even if it's not like that, but it is indeed education, education is key in everything. The story goes, spoiler alert, it's a bad ending, but education is so important, vou can mean so much to young people, make sure they have an open mind in their middle school. That's what it's really about later. In Schaarbeek, in that school, where everyone plays the role of headscarf, what is extremely different for Latifah is that there is a lot of knowledge. Here she goes over to Naya,

so she goes more that way.

Now,

Fuat is actually of the opinion

that her world actually became very small

from that moment.

She married a 17-year-old

with Murat,

who was a distant relative

to Latifah's mother.

And that would also be a lovely event, of course.

Now

Fuat tells in the article

that Murat

was still a distant relative

of her family.

Fuat says,

I couldn't believe that Latifah

became a distant relative

and nicer.

He thinks, of course,

that she could have become a scientist.

Of course, there is nothing wrong with both,

but I understand that

there needs to be frustration

with Fuat, of course.

You see, she changes from school

and she gets the feeling that

she is also a distant relative.

Yes, she is also a distant relative,

so of course she depends on the fact that

everything is changed until she goes to that school.

I understand her point of view.

Yes, and she also says

that Murat will follow the evening lessons of France.

But

Latifah shouldn't go to the evening school

because it was a mixed class,

boys and girls.

But Fuat says

that Murat

will follow the evening class.

Why don't you do that?

And she doesn't.

But Latifah became very fond of her brother

and he kept his mouth $% \left(1\right) =\left(1\right) \left(1\right)$

for the love of peace.

Yes.

Now, what has changed

when Latifah went to Schaarbeek?

She has reached the stage

of a certain non-school association

that is now known as

the VZW La Plume.

As you can see

together with

Muslim sisters.

La Plume was founded

by the 52-year-old

and I hope I'm going to say this

Abdelkrim Asnagoui.

The 52-year-old ex-stimmerman,

ex-foreigner,

ex-installateur of Jackpots

in Café.

He had a lot of life, this man.

And in the 1980s

he was from a turbulent nightlife in Brussels.

And he made

a switch

to religion but

in a fairly extreme form.

He grew his beard

and would wear a short pants.

And he profiled himself

as a Koran teacher

and an Islamic genius.

He had no education

but he would say

I'm self-taught.

He specialized

in one specific type

of Islamic genius

which is Rokya.

In the broad sense of the word

it means Rokya, the traditional

Islamic genius.

He didn't

go there

at all.

There was something very specific

in his approach

and that is exorcism.

He used

a lot of equipment

to genius people.

He had an assistant

to the Muslim-based Belgian Xavier Meerd.

He took his new name

Selim.

And the two met

by the extremist Muslim

milieu in Brussels.

I found out a little bit about Xavier.

Yes.

He is the one who

set up the VZ2.

It is known by Abdelkrim.

But Xavier set it up

and he specialized in his 14th.

It was all fine for his mother

who said

he never had problems with Xavier.

He thought about his mother

for a very long time.

A well thought out choice.

A well thought out choice indeed.

But in the end he would

turn the well thought out choice

into an obsession, according to his mother.

Xavier doesn't have a social life anymore

but because of the VZ2

he goes back

on the ladder.

He gets to see him again.

He is very interested

in the traditional genesis

but it is not based on a teaching

but it is written

on his own interpretation

and fantasy.

That is always a good start for something like that.

Exactly.

Fouad describes the VZ2 as a kind of disease and I don't think you can see that. He claims that Latifah was looking for her until evening and that outside he almost lost contact with her. We as foreigners didn't really know what was going on there but it was clear that the influence of those two men on those young women who were a part of VZ2 was enormous. They were isolated and they were easy to manipulate. Everything was still due to the information about demons, witchcraft, god services, fanatics. Not really a healthy environment. Latifah was a part of VZ2 La Plume but she wasn't really looking for solutions with the Islamic genesis until she had a problem Yes, I wanted to say that she was in the first session just for god's lessons and arabic lessons so she wasn't really dealing with those genesis. No, absolutely not. But suddenly a problem came to herself where she was with two men she had a problem with children and they didn't get pregnant so she went to Xavier and Abdel Karim Abdel Karim Yes, I thought that was Abdel Karim but

Abdel Karim, indeed

I see different names because further in my research I also see Abdel Kader I hope that we don't have Abdel Karim. Abdel Karim, yes. So she goes to those two men and they let her know and convince her that she was pregnant and that only a devil could save her. And Murat really enjoyed that she wanted to have a different idea in the beginning but Latifah was convinced and she believed herself that the devil was in her so Murat went with her to help the devil and they started two months before her death and Latifah was already in the war with the first treatment she wasn't so good at reacting Murat actually called the parents of Latifah who were in Morocco at that time they were back then Latifah at her house in the society of Abdel Karim she had other assistants and for what she said we can see that she was thinking about the movie The Exorcist she was apparently tied to hands and feet she had to drink a lot of drinks she was completely weak she had stupids but for everyone in that house it looked normal

no one was there and then Abdel Karim started to read now Latifah's father Ramdan excuse me he really said everyone outside he wanted to call a doctor but the female assistants who were there also under the leadership of Abdel Karim actually refused to leave because Abdel Karim said a doctor will only send Latifah in psychiatry and then she will stay for the rest of her life so she asked Latifah's father to let him do what he did because he knew what he did but the father said and Latifah's parents stayed there for 4 days to take care of her non-stop she gave her vitamins she ate a lot she really took good care of her and she will come back on top now Latifah's father asked Murat to take care of Latifah along with a psychologist and then they were on the advice of the psychologist they went to France for 2 weeks to be in between and Murat also promised

to leave Latifah but he broke his word yes flash forward to 10 days before her death Latifah decided to take a new attempt to get rid of her demons and she went back to Abdel Karim but he was not in the country and not available but they are being friendly Safiye who had seen enough how teachers are and he could do it he also wants to be in life I can do this but also in that way imagine that they would be there that I learn something I read a book podcast maker for dummies and I say to you I think I can do this yes, let's do this and we did it I mean I like that people are curious and interested in life but when it comes to genius there are people who studied and they can do better than you sorry without doubt I mean no, I was giving bad examples there are no other examples don't play with your health it is clear look at our family

go to a psychologist great advice but Latifah unfortunately is so convinced that he is with demons in his body and Abdel Karim says, Safiye Meerd he is going to help you further and Murat, the real genius of Latifah he decides to take a new attempt and he screams Latifah from that moment from her family he makes sure that there is no contact her parents would have stood in front of the door in the period he followed he never did it openly he really made sure that Latifah could work alone with her demons and her demons from the driver we are ten days before her death and Safive Meerd is in the apartment to drive the devil out how is he going to do that? what does he have with him? he has Ouran texts which he wrote on a piece of paper or plastic then he put it in warm water so that it dissolves the saffron and that dve Latifah had to drink as much as possible and then there was a bath with hot water that's where the Quran was put

because that would burn the demon Murat has decided that everything has been put into place and I can believe that they really want to do everything to solve the fertility problem so until then we have a devil excursion Safive Meerd has two female assistants and she lets me do the dirty work we have Jamila she had a devil excursion and since then she has been specialized in finding the demons and she also helps other victims this is really a standard Stockholm syndrome that's what Jamila is and what she has to do she is convinced that there is a button in Latifah's skull and that there is a really strong demon locked up so it takes so much time to break two fingers in Latifah's skull and then she lets the fingers in the skull and massages them from inside the button in her skull to get that demon if Latifah is not in the bath and no brown water is drinking she gets a headphone tied to her head I think where the Koran verse is recited

when she wants to sleep the headphone is also busy SO how they work is also clear in that article of the humor and in that later on the police complain that in the first instance we were only offering but we noticed that it has little effect so that's why they started with the bath and he says that sometimes Latifah doesn't want to sit in the bath sometimes not we had to swim with the three of us and it is clear the water was hot but not cooking thank you Xavier and what is also clear is that Latifah was tied in the case of the demon in her head now they think that with a spider web and a camera a centurion has happened he says yes it happens that we lower her head but that was very short but really very short and Latifah tried to get up but Xavier says that was her survival instinct and the devil who doesn't drink water and I agree that he did it because he voted for it and it was the devil who came up he connects his actions to the devil and he forgets that there is a person and a body where

there is no devil but he speaks his actions well to say that he tried the devil and he says that Latifah was often exposed to such a session but also sometimes they didn't react and really had to be helped by the bathroom where they were put in a seat and they put their headphones back on but all the officials say we have never beaten her don't forget the child had knifes very nicely Xavier still has a addition and he says we have never beaten her there was a bitstock but I took it away because I thought it might seem suspicious but I didn't agree with that it turned out to be a toilet which was covered with Koran verses and he says I sometimes have a body part but I didn't agree I think we now know where the blue spot comes from Latifah sometimes also resisted against the attempts of Jamila to use her what did Jamila do then she opened the can of Latifah now eating so we know that she had to drink a lot of water but she didn't drink more than 2 liters of yoghurt per day because she didn't use any food

but just the bad substance so that's why she got the yoghurt served we didn't get much than a white paper a bit like lime and Xavier says we know from experience that it's magic so we went there for 9 days because if you eat your yoghurt and you cut a white paper then it's definitely duffels that's definitely duffels so we went there for 9 days Latifah the child still reacts I think there was 23 I don't know half unconscious with still the head up plastic of course under but the exorcists were for sure that it couldn't last longer before the Jins as it's called would give up now Jamila said I noticed that the Jinn the demon in Latifah's belly is poisoned which is good news because then they can get children who are sitting in their eyes and also one more dangerous who was in a cage so suddenly the fingers deep in Latifah's mouth and then it's August 4 the day before Latifah's death it's been quite a while but this is the highlight

of the devil edition

Xavier asked Murat to let a bath to put Latifah in there and to let her drink a black soup it was a mix between an oily extract and that Ouran water and then Murat the servant started to spartle Latifah Xavier took his beard and Xavier thought about it it was so hard that I had to do a great she also drew a line that woman used in the last episode to put her in there instead of taking her out of the bath they decided to put her under water and to keep her so that she stays in the water that's also why she's being tarnished we didn't hit Latifah but on the Jinn who was in her and that's why she asked what she did to each other Murat indicated that he was calling the aid service because it seemed that Latifah stopped breathing but that all the rest of the voices were given that the Jinn would be the last force and that's what she was doing that she certainly didn't have to stop there's still someone in the phone and that's Xavier that the situation is not going well

and he calls who else is the teacher Abdul Karim that band is in Morocco Xavier explains the situation and he only has one question for Abdul Karim namely what should I do when Latifah comes to die you know what you have to do to get out of there but what if it goes wrong and I don't know what Xavier I thought the answer was that I expected if that happens then you take your bullet and then you're gone great, that's the people you leave the aid services were eventually contacted because Latifah stopped breathing and when they arrive Murat is alone at home so that means that Xavier has followed up the good advice of his teacher together with the WC to get out of there something later Latifah's father arrived who was going to call for him he saw his daughter in the morning and that evening he left as we already said in the hospital now you already know that Murat is known so two years later a group of exorcists for the correctional court were beaten and wounded with the death but

there were very light punishments roll your eyes out of my pocket yes, so I read it before Xavier was 5 years old and didn't have to go to the prison his assistant was a few months old that Latifah's husband was 4 years old and Abdul Karim who, as they say, was morally responsible was released Fouad the whole family was angry and he said that the correctional court allowed him to be arrested by the lawyers who said it was about a cultural abuse owned by Islam where an accident happened but Fouad didn't say it was about a mental disorder alcohol, beatings, beatings Fouad, a platform, please so the reason I wanted to make this episode was because I wanted to talk about exorcisms and when I came to this I was surprised because I really believe in exorcisms with the Christian faith of course by all the horror films that were made about it so I found it very interesting to see that it is about religion, borders and so on so we also studied exorcisms black magic first in Islam and later in other faiths in the article of Humo

they let the anthropologist

Philip Hermans on it why not? you are my favourite anthropologist humo call me my favourite anthropologist was not available Philip Hermans also wrote a book I think that the man just said I would do a Xavi because I know everything but actually not but he has deepened himself in the Moroccan folk culture and he wrote the book the world of the gin I also want to say for everyone with an alcohol problem that he thinks about gin the drink is I knew nothing about it I took this information as a case really I find it so difficult so apparently almost all Muslims it is a pity that you do not get an anthropologist you studied anthropology I think that is something for you that would be for me but I would like to read about it it is also a lot of rabbit holes but in a good way so I would read something for an exam and then I would be there and the rest would not be taught that would have been to me I can imagine apparently it would be good if all Muslims believed in the existence of gin they are written in the Quran

they would be created by Allah in which it is said you have male and female gin good and bad, believing and unbelieving and also getting children they can fly through walls training in camps sometimes they come to our world and then they always have bad intentions it is a bit the culture of gestures that we have that is also described in Islam the official Islam is very clear they do not let black magic they do recognize the existence of it a bit like hard drugs in Belgium we know that it exists but it is not allowed strange people go to people who call themselves deaf and hard of hearing to let others deaf and hard of hearing there was a very very nice testimony in the article a woman who tells her brother in the slaughterhouse of Anderlecht and there was a woman who came to him to ask a very specific question that man was like no sorry, not in our drama but you want me to order it and what are you going to do with it where you are probably really interested in how you make it ready to eat for that you did not use that woman because it was necessary for Hexer they were going to make a drink that would make sure that the person you really enjoyed

would serve you as a deaf person yes I find it very fascinating I find it very fascinating where are they, they are everywhere but why do you take the most risk to get them in your body that is in big rows slaughterhouses and my biggest fear the toilet every day I go to a toilet sit once sometimes at home, sometimes at work and now there is a cobra in my vagina that is the fear also with me and now I realize that I am already afraid of the gins you know, there is already one in you I don't want to make it ridiculous but so they come to you they also have food preferences they really like blood and milk I wrote three on it that you know gins are celebrity gins I find it very fascinating so you have Aisha Kendisha she is a very beautiful woman she appears to be for men but then it turns out that she has lelechis and bouquets you have Pasha Hammu she is a male gen that is very strong and has a lot of blood fuck him because he takes care of

menstruation with women and he drives people to overweight alcoholism and auto mutilation I find it less funny than a beautiful woman who suddenly has bouquets and last but not least I wrote down Um Soubien she is also a fallen young woman but actually she is old she has slingshot and there comes smoke from her nose and she falls specifically on two population groups pregnant women and small children and she is going to sleep because there comes under her bed to sit down a lot of muslims no orthodox officers they believe in muslims they believe a little bit but they like it just like we believe in gins and it is actually only if something goes wrong in their lives that they will eventually find a genesis in belgium it would mainly be for psychical diseases and for general events muslims have faith in the classic genesis I would like to say that I have mentioned it but the number of gins is very different compared to the Brom that you have read some Ouran scholars estimate that there are 68 billion so boy look

who knows

but I would like to because it is really I was today years old that I knew about the existence of a gen so if muslims are listenable let us know do you believe in it? do you believe in gins? how do you deal with it? are there special things that you do? I am curious you said that the real one has to be recognized by the Islam because it has to happen by a Quran and that is important for this story because we have heard a lot about fulterings and martins but actually the demons, the gins can be derived but only by Ouran there is an article in Scharebeek because what has played out we think more about scholars who do not know how far they can go it seems to me that recitation of the Quran also seems to me something but maybe I will interpret because it is repetitive that you come across a kind of meditation that someone who is psychically un-Russian can make calm and understand where recitation comes and to touch someone

I understand where

the non-traditional is but it is good that it is clear that it is the one that helps and all the rest we have talked about Islam but let's be honest this is not just an Islamic as you say we will talk about the Christian we have a few examples where it seems that it is very common in Christianity as Paul Francis in 2013 on the St. Peter's Pines Rome such as himself a duvel excursion when he put his hand on the head of a man with a restriction which is in the article weird to react I do not know what is meant by that now the Christian exorcists who immediately put their hand on the head that is one of our methods we know that so according to the exorcists Paul Francis also did an exorcism now the Vatican says again that the paus just wants to pray for that man but the paus himself said that the priests do not have to pray for the spiritual, historical and exorcist to change that and I found this very strange so we have here in belgium the website kerknet.be I am also going to look

and it is still on the cover in a news article to a lecture for exorcists in the Vatican that is an initiative of the Saaserdos or Sacredos Institute in cooperation with the International **Association for Exorcists** and there is kerknet.be and more and more there is an international association for exorcists they are there I then in the article of HumoSaisen then also called to the Abbey of Averbode where there are who are still regularly asked for exorcisms so the interviewer asks how many people have been a thousand people but now it is much, much, much less so they are still asking and how much right now when it is much less come daily people for an exorcism what? see, there is so much more to come and I didn't know that I am really shocked everyone has to do what they want everyone has to believe in what they want but this has nothing to do with faith and love and friendship and the doubts

the word exorcism is missing

from the fact that

get out Knakke is also going to ask how is it at the Jodendom if we are still going to go over and then he says, look at us it is not really about the devil the so-called diboek so you have to believe that if someone dies the person's goal will remain but there are in the case without it where the goal can get a second chance to improve yourself in other people's so if you have missed it in your first life you don't do it anymore they say you have a Sunday without life and then there is without a chance it is a bit like Rat van Vorduin exactly now what is the feeling when the diboek comes to sit in another human body is that you can get dreams that don't seem to come from yourself or that you can't even place but as you said there is almost no exorcism but they are going to talk about the person in question but in the article it is said I doubt if they are going to organize themselves and sometimes do a lot of exaggeration so the person in the article has interviewed he savs it doesn't but Bonn of course never knows

what is going on I think it is nice that something like that comes back in all cultures ves indeed so to make it really clear that it is not only in Islam that there is no reaction from you know now the family of Latifah to go back to that they are obviously frustrated they are angry about the dirty stuff that they received in the correctional bank and they say we just want to go to Assizehov and that those things are treated there and indeed they get the chance the case goes to Assizehov and the case was then qualified as a full-time that was necessary to get Assizehov we are standing there Murat, Abdel Karim Xavier and the assistant Jamila, Fatima and Hayate now Murat, Xavier, Jamila and Fatima are guilty of following the death but without the intention to kill Xavier was more responsible for the continuation of the treatment despite the deteriorating condition of the victim and the concerns he had that is written in the arrest both other guilty Abdel Karim and Hayate were also guilty of following

but they spoke more freely about the serious circumstances the jury members were responsible that Xavier and Murat were the two responsible for the beatings they had before then the jury also judged that Jamila and Fatima had determined that the victim was in a coma and they then did not call for the help because they also made themselves guilty of the crime Jamila also tried to make them guilty while they were already aware of what the doctors said as very dangerous of course when you are aware of it and you are still going to use it, then it is the chance that you also stick to it after that the jury also judged that Abdel Karim came in June 2004 at the beginning of the session and that he could not be responsible for the death of Latifah but they also made those allegations for Havate and they said that is not true since July 29 they had no contact with the victims or were they held back so I think it is the same so with her they said we already talked about it I am going to start this petition hold the word again

and I think it is again wrong in the Netherlands with Hayate they also said she is also not responsible for the death of Latifah because she had no contact since July 29 and she died in August 5 on the Assisi process Moura and Xavier were sentenced to 9 years for the death of Latifah Jamila and Fatima were sentenced to 5 years and Abdel Karim and Hayate were sentenced to 3 years SO better but not much better families of course were deeply hurt but they could start their raw process and you would think here it stops and on the word it is Abdel Karim who even tells about his work as an exorcist because he is still on strike he doesn't deny that and he says in the article I am constantly dealing with devil's intentions people keep coming to me I have already done more than 1000 and Minilem minimizes his prejudice but my lawyer

gave me that

the only thing I wanted to do was to help Latifah her parents were grateful I am getting very aggressive but I will finish he savs when Latifah was in Morocco I had advised her to do the ritual medicine but she would die in the hospital and not at home during the process I told the police that you are welcome to visit to see such a devil's intention and I asked the hospital staff to help the patient to recite the Quran I am convinced that I will be able to help so many patients what the fuck shut this guy up this guy is Delulu here I am getting angry I am really getting angry of course I am not saying that you are not responsible but you are very, very responsible but this is so God complex absolutely and you just don't want to see you don't want to recognize that you did something wrong and within that you get the impression that I am the one who has done thousands of exorcisms and there you go we are sold really terrible you can see that it is not going well and he is going to keep doing this

and it is going to be even worse of course yes, there are 999 well done if there is one thousandth mistake yes not at all especially in this untrusted there are always mistakes the risks are so real you know what the other 999 people are going to keep going yes, indeed and as you can see extremism is just good for nothing you see the family of Latifah was good she was good in that way people who look at religion in a very healthy way what it is really good but if you get lost in radical circumstances then it is just not going well no that's it yes, it was a very difficult thing especially because it happened in Schaar right next to us and that it just still happens ves, because this is read as a bad horror movie but this is just recent and reality interesting, I am happy that you can dive into very certainly thank you for listening yes, thank you all I thought you were saying thank you also thank you, thank you for being here
