Weston, in fact, is the name of the city of Massa Chassets,

where his son Eugène learned the technique that makes the brand specific.

Ah yeah?

Yeah, and if Wembany chose them,

it's because their skin tannery is located in Saint-Léonard-de-Noblard in Haut-de-Vienne,

a city where his grandparents have a house.

And above all, because only Weston was able to take the challenge of making him a giant moccasin, hang on, 57.

Ah, it's not feet, it's the ski.

To give you an idea, the average point of a French is 43.

It's a foot of 27 cm long,

he is 37 cm 10 more.

As you can see, at Weston, we had never made moccasins of this size.
