for how far out I am allowed to go to the boat.

that it is possible to make their own economy.

you can of course

in relation to how you can
deal with international humanitarian rights,

But there are now two people
who also live in this over time
and some of the questions that I have
engaged in, I have been what happens
with these people group
in this conflict for a long time.

We can talk about this later.

but they break themselves in such a time
that people take in much greater degree

an active choice to move to Tel Aviv
